

## Stratton burials from 1813 - 1907

The purpose is to find the occupation and location, which gives an indication of life expectancy in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. A problem with female population is they were often unrecorded agricultural labourers, with reduced life expectancy. Infant and mother mortality often struck down both social classes down at birth or shortly afterwards. Contagious disease through poor sanitary practice and overcrowding contributed to deaths again of all social classes. Against this there are a minority of deaths at the age of 80 and even 93. There are some burials listed which are coloured black, are of persons with no positive reason found why they were buried at Stratton, although often due to retirement from farming outside the area or related to original Stratton families. Birth years are given, but infant deaths may be up to 10 years of age.

Blue is for the early residents and those born before 1800.

Green indicates persons found in census from 1841 to 1901 or resident at some time in Stratton.

Starred \* persons indicate a family link ie. Husband and wife's death often occurring in close proximity. Family partners died of the same ailment or more often death in childbirth.

Black. "transient" to reflect agricultural labour mobility that was increasing by 1830's, as the yeomen farmers of the Cotswolds shed what little village labour they used due to the lack of coherent government control of food prices after the Napoleonic Wars.

Also burial of persons without an obvious Stratton connection, not appearing in residence in the decade between two census dates.

Orange is families of note

## Conclusion

The Old Churchyard must have had over time a thousand persons buried there. The area from the Church path to the Grange farm wall is singularly vacant of burial indication, as is the area from the back of the Church to the Oakley road. It's not unreasonable to suppose this may be where the multi occupation of burials occurred. Certainly there is no reference to skeletons being found elsewhere in the Parish although from an ancient perspective I would favour the land opposite the new cemetery where large houses were built. The views from there are dramatic to the Bathurst Park and the Daglingworth valley.

The longevity of families resident in the Parish is borne out by the births and burials. In the 19<sup>th</sup> century only three residents are credited with reaching 90 years. A paradox is they were from poor families. Through each century from 1500's to early 1800's when agricultural work was the main occupation there is transient population of around 40%. Earlier this was drawn from Daglingworth and the Duntisbourne's but expanded to villages as far away as Northleach by 1800. From 1830 there is an influx as the employers in the further away communities ran down there labouring requirements. These people appear only to have stayed for a few years and moved on. Not so much mobility of labour but necessity as the Parish Poor Relief was parsimonious. An example of the Parish Relief manipulation is the threat of withdrawal should they profess to be dissenters. After this there is a movement towards Cirencester for employment of the next generation. Many worked on the Bathurst estate up till 1960 when that work force was cut from 50 to 9.

By 1830 we see the last of the husbandman descendents of the 15thC/16thC families buried. There had been five to seven husbandmen who were of the parish in those times. The last members were often widows and the offspring have moved away. An example would be 1820 Martha Winton of Farringdon buried December 7<sup>th</sup> age 55 (1765). The Winton family had been in Stratton 1600 to 1700.

Its notable social example in the case of Louisa Trustham Str. Died Nov.20 1908, age 56 , described as being ignorant and poor.
